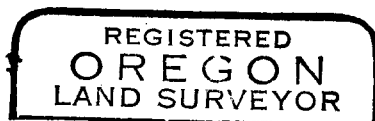

In Township 23 South Range 5 West.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the G.A. Burt Donation Land Claim No. 40 in Township 23 South Range 5 West which is a large stone well planted in the ground at the corner of the graveyard fence thence I run East on the E.P. line at 627 feet Southeast corner of Yoncalla Cemetery 1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at fence corner at 907 feet Southeast corner of Mesonic Cemetery 1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at this point the initial point for the Cemetery survey bears North 647.9 feet which is a galvanized pipe 3" X 30 inches long firmly set in the ground. I now return to the Southeast corner run East 305.1 feet to a stone 6x8 inches in the ground with a cross thence I run East 13.8 feet to a 3/4 inch pipe thence East on claim line 120 feet to the West side of Old Highway leading from Yoncalla to Oakland at a 3/4 inch iron pipe thence South along West side of Highway 120 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe thence West 120 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe thence North 120 feet to the place of beginning. In section 4 containing 33/100 of an acre.
