Boundary" signs and blazed trees.

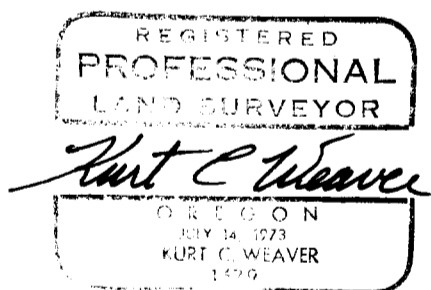
Procedure: Utilizing a series of closed traverses
