Survey For: Umpqua National Forest

Location: Located in the Southwest quarter of Section  
28, Township 31 South, Range 1 West of the  
Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.

Purpose: To monument the CW 1/16 corner and the SW  
1/16 corner of Section 28. Also, to mark  
the North, South and East lines of the  
Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter  
with posts and "Forest Boundary" signs.

Procedure: Utilizing a series of closed traverses I  
tied the controlling corners shown on the  
accompanying map. This was done with a  
Wild T-2 theodolite and an H.P. 3805A  
E.D.M.

Monuments were set as shown on the  
accompanying map.

Bearing was based on a solar observation.
