SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250.

Survey For: UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST

Location: Located in the Northeast and Southwest quarters of Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.

Purpose: The survey was performed to monument the corners of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 33. Also, to allow for the marking of the boundaries of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 with posts and "Forest Boundary" signs and blazed trees. As well as to mark with posts and "Forest Boundary" signs the North, West, South and the South 3/4 of the East lines of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4. This was done as illustrated on the accompanying maps.

Procedure: Utilizing a series of closed traverses I tied the controlling corners shown on the accompanying maps. This was done with a Wild T-2 theodolite and an H.P. 3805 A E.D.M.

Monuments were found and set as shown on the accompanying maps.

Bearing was based on a solar observation.
