Location: Located in the Northwest and Southwest
quarters of Section 34, Township 31 South,
Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian,
Douglas County, Oregon.

Purpose: To monument the interior Section corners
and to post the Forest Boundary as shown
on the accompanying maps. The boundaries
were posted with "Forest Boundary" signs
attached to posts.

Procedure: Utilizing a series of closed traverses I
tied the controlling corners shown on the
accompanying maps. This was done with a
Wild T-2 theodolite and a H.P/ 3805A
E.D.M. Random lines were run along the
subdivisional lines of the section and
closed into previous control traverses.
Monumentation and posting was accomplished
from these lines.

Monuments were set as shown on the
accompanying map.

Bearing was based on a solar observation.
