NARRATIVE

COUNTY SURVEYOR
DOUGLAS COUNTY, ORE.

FOR: Feather Hill Farm - Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32,
T. 22 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

PURPOSE: To survey perimeter of property.

PROCEDURE: A search was made to locate the following original corners: N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner and the Southwest corner of section 30; also, the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of section 31. I could not find any evidence of these corners.

Using the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the East line of section 29 as the basis of bearings I tied all the existing corners by random traverse. The W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of section 32 was tied in by the Douglas County Surveyor's Office as the surrounding property owners would not allow my crew to set foot on their properties.

I proportioned the missing corners in sections 30 and 31 and then subdivided the sections.

The portion of the property lying in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 31, by description, is bordered on the south by the north line of Government Lot 1; therefore, I proportioned the north line of Government Lot 1 using the distance calls of the lines in the William Hayhurst D.L.C. No. 42, field notes.

I ALSO CALCULATED ~~and~~ set the west-southwest corner by proportion. I set the corners shown on the annexed map.

EQUIPMENT: Theodolites, EDM's and steel chain.
