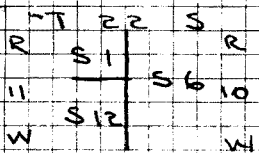


# RENEWAL



## FOUND

1. A STONE 16x12x7

INCHES. STONE HAS 1 NOTCH ON NORTHERLY EDGE AND 5 NOTCHES ON SOUTHERLY EDGE, "X" CHISELED ON TOP.

STONE LOCATED AT THE BASE OF A SMALL SLIDE AREA.

2. A FIR 12 NOW 28 INCHES DIAMETER, BEARS N 18° W, 45<sup>5</sup> FEET (REC. N 13° W 43<sup>5</sup> FEET). I PARTIALLY OPEN BLAZE AND FIND SCRIBING "S 1".

3. A FIR 36 NOW A 55 INCH DIAMETER WINDFALL BADLY ROTTED, BEARS S 8° W, 72<sup>2</sup> FEET APPYX (REC S 6° 50' W, 70<sup>2</sup> FT). TREE SCRIBED "R 11 W".

A DOUGLAS FIR, 10 INCHES DIAMETER BEARS S 58 1/2° W, 10 7/8 FEET. TREE DOUBLE BLAZED AND SCRIBED "T 22 S R 11 W S 12 CS BT".

ORIGINAL, 12 INCH FIR, BEARS N 13° W, 43 1/2 FEET.
