1. A STONE (CONGLOMERATE) 7" X 5" X 8"

Above ground, firmly set at old fence corner. Stone tied as DLC corner by Northcraft 1972.

2. An oak is now a stump 24

inches in diameter, Y near base. Stump bears S 55° W, 29² feet. Tree has possible blaze, rotted, no scribbling found.

3. A black oak is now 20 inch

diameter bears N 76° W, 40² feet. Tree scribbled "NE COR DLC BT", by Northcraft, as B.T. to stone. I open tree,

(this destroys Northcraft scribbles)
