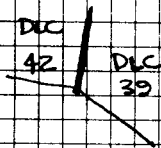

(SEE REN. # 17 AND MAP FILE M 60-68)

FOUND:

AN 18" X 18" X 24" SANDSTONE, FIRMLY SET 10" IN THE GROUND, WITH A CHISELED "X" ON TOP AND CHISELED "CL 42" ON NE FACE, (SEE REN. #17)

FROM WHICH:

A POINT OF EXPOSED BEDROCK WITH CHISELED MARKINGS "X CL 42" BEARS S 29° W 22<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> FT. (REC. PER REN. #17 S 25° 30' W 22<sup>0</sup>/<sub>4</sub> FT.)

WE CANNOT DETECT ANY SIGNS OF DISTURBANCE IN THE VICINITY OF THE FOUND STONE EVEN THOUGH IT'S POSITION DISAGREES WITH THE RECORDED MEASUREMENTS TO THE FOUND BEARING OBJECT AND IT'S MARKINGS "CL 42" FACE DLC 39.

WE DO NOT FIND THE BEARING OBJECT LOCATED  
S 80° W 50 ± FT., AS NOTED IN REN. #17.

THERE IS NO REMAINING EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL  
CORNER STONE OR ITS BEARING TREES.

WE DO NOT SET A BRASS CAP DUE TO A SOIL  
DEPTH OF APPROX. ONE FOOT TO BEDROCK.

WE MARK TWO NEW BEARING OBJECTS AS  
FOLLOWS:

A CHISELED "X BO" IN 3 INCH HIGH LETTERS  
ON EXPOSED BEDROCK AT THE TOP OF AN  
APPROX. 30 FT. HIGH CLIFF OVERLOOKING  
THE UMPQUA RIVER BEARS S 18° E  
13 ± FT.

A CHISELED "Δ BO" IN 2 INCH HIGH  
LETTERS ON EXPOSED BEDROCK APPROX.  
15 FT. NORTH OF THE TOP OF A 30 FT. HIGH  
CLIFF OVERLOOKING THE UMPQUA RIVER  
BEARS S 81° W 17 ± FT.
