Set alongside cap is a 4"x5"x16" sandstone marked "CS 1/4 S" from B.B. Irving survey CS 53/86.

Accessories Found: (Condition and Source) An original 16"

oak is gone but we find small young oaks growing from apparent stump hole depression at record bearing and distance. No evidence of original 9" fir.

From CS 53/86 a 16" now a 32" W. Oak at record bearing and distance has healed single blaze, no scribbling visible and a 5" now an 11" W. Oak at record

bearing and distance has healed single blaze no
scribing visible (this tree now has trunk grown together
with 3 other W. Oaks, center of trunks measures
38³ ft. from corner, same bearing as record)

Monument Set: (Procedure and Description) From renewal # 136

a 6" now a 10" D. Fir bears N43°E, 17³ ft (record
N40°E 17³ ft.) single healed blaze no scribing visible.
And a 10" now 13" D. Fir at record bearing and
distance has healed double blaze no scribing visible.
From renewal # 23 Haines "T" Iron bears N55°W, 62² ft.

New Accessories: (Description)

(record N 52¹/₂°W 62² ft) At Haines "T" Iron we find
no evidence of Haines B.T.'s. "T" iron is loosely set
and protruding 10" from ground.

* We retag all trees where bearing and/or distance
differences were noted.
