since then (as noted in renewal #1) From renewal #61 a 12" Cedar now a 17" by 25 ft tall cedar snag bears S 11° W, 85 ³/₄ ft (record S 11° W, 83 ⁶/₄ ft) partially healed single blaze ^(Haines washer at bottom of blaze) has scribing "T 21 S R 6 W S 30" visible (should be S 36). And a 16" now a 24" D. Fir bears N 53° W, 52 ³/₄ ft (record N 53° W 54 ³/₄ ft) double blaze no scribing visible. From renewal #113 a 12" now


