Monument(s) Found: (Condition and Source) A 1" x 36" iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap is loosely set, leaning north west and protruding 12" from ground. Cap is marked: "U.S. GENERAL LAND OFFICE SURVEY"

Accessories Found: (Condition and Source) A search is made for the original 1926 bearing trees. The original 28" D. fir is now a 28" x 42" high D. fir stump, bearing N 08° E, 25<sup>±</sup> ft. dist. (record N 09° E, 26<sup>±</sup> ft.). This tree has a healed single blaze, upon opening the lower part of this blaze a scribed "BT" is found. The original 24" Sugar pine is now a 24" x 42" <sup>(high)</sup> Sugar pine

stump, bearing  $S 61^{\circ} W$ , 192 ft. dist (record  $S 64^{\circ} W$ , 192 ft).

The blaze on this stump has apparently rotted off no scribing is found. Also a 40" x 50" high D. fir stump is found bearing  $S 50^{\circ} E$ , 142 ft dist. This stump is tagged with a Forest Service location tag posted July 6, 1953. This stump is not blazed RENEWAL or scribed.

Monument Set: (Procedure and Description) Because of monuments loosened condition the original location is determined by intersecting the original bearings and distances as measured from the found original BT stumps; this position is referenced out, the loose caps removed and then reestablished firmly at the referenced position.

Pipe and cap now protrude 6" from soil and is approx. 0.2 ft SW of found position.

New Accessories: (Description) Original bearing trees (now stumps) are now found at original record bearings and distances, and the southeast bearing 40" x 50" high D. fir stump now bears  $S 52 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ , 142 ft. dist. Because no other suitable bearing trees are available and the found stumps are reasonably sound, these stumps are tagged with DCSO BT tags and no new accessories are added.
