Accessories Found: (Condition and Source) An original 60" D. Fir now an approximately 15 ft. tall, 67" DBH D. Fir snag bears S43 1/2° E, 56' ft. (record S41 1/2° E, 56' ft.); tree has opened blaze with the scribing "1/4 523 B" visible. An original 30" D. Fir now a 20" DBH x 8 ft (approx) tall Fir ^{snag} bears N44 1/2° W, 60' ft. (as per record); no scribing remains on this tree. From renewal # 55 a 34" now a 35" DBH D. fir bears N18° W,

52⁵ ft (as per record); partially healed single blaze has the scribing "1/4 S 14 CS BT" visible. And a 30" now a 31" DBH D. Fir bears S 39 1/2° E, 89² ft (record S 37° E, 89² ft); tree has partially healed single blaze with "1/4 S 23" scribing visible.
