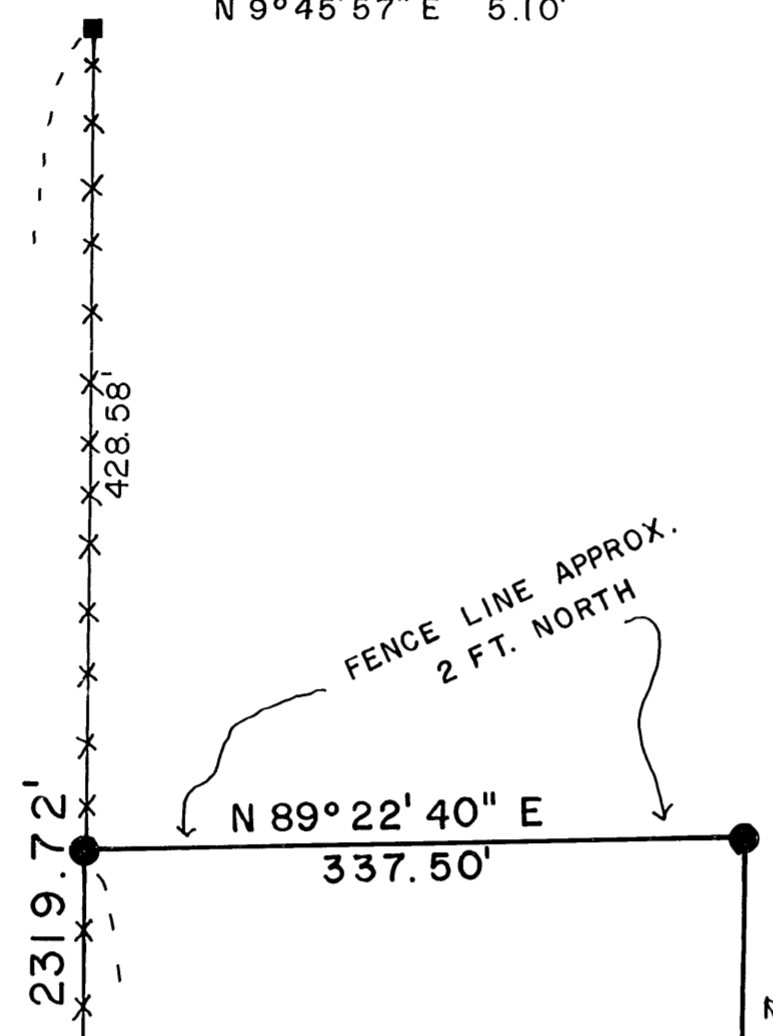

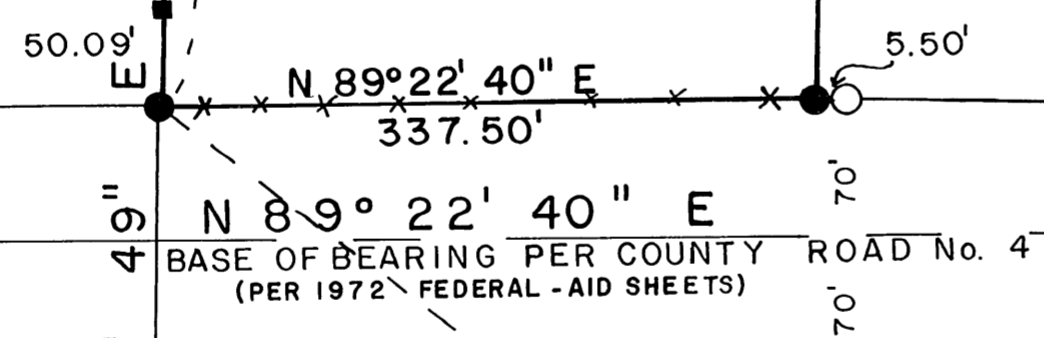

The purpose of this survey was to locate Douglas County Stockpile Number 00413.5 as described in Clerk's Recording Number 66-9336.

The Southwest corner of D.L.C. No. 40 as shown on Survey M 70-68 has been accepted for many years as evidenced by the fence lines in the area.

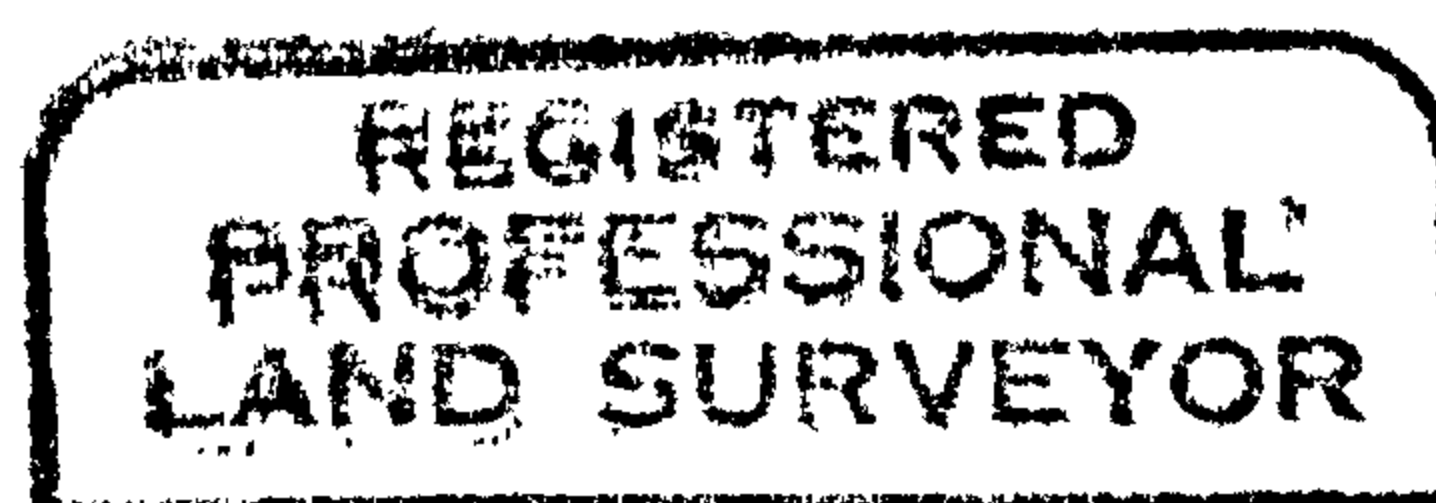
There was found no evidence to locate that corner in any other position. Additional ties to other corners were made and not shown that support the position of this corner. That information is in the same C. S. File as this narrative.

The West line of D.L.C. No. 40 North of the Southwest corner was established by the two fence posts shown on the survey map.

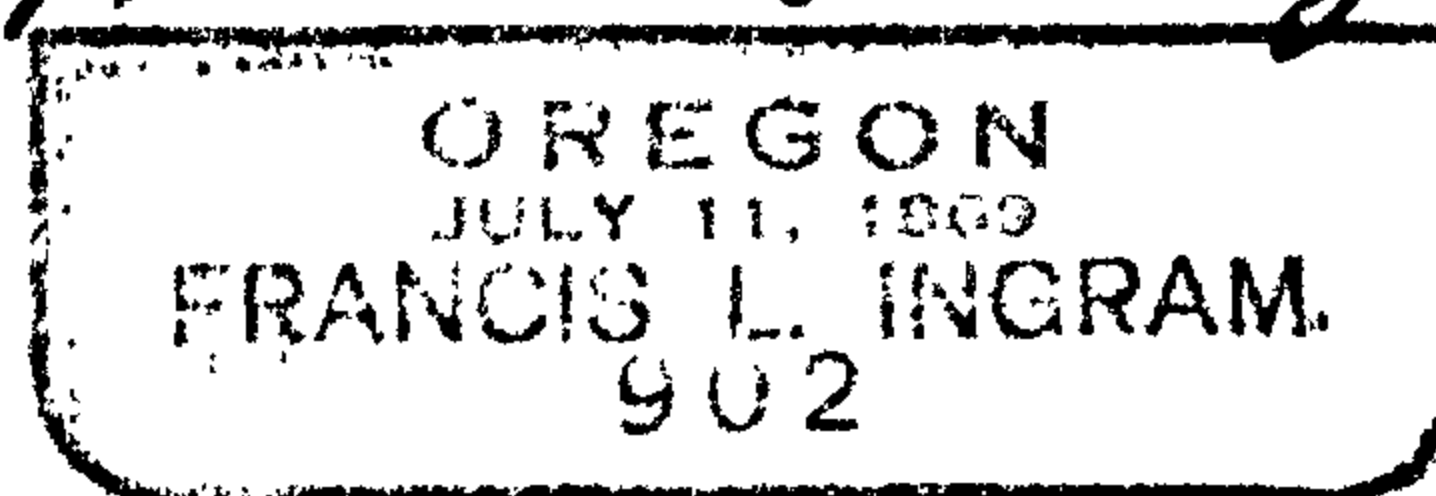
The East and West lines of the stockpile site are twenty feet shorter than described in the deed because of additional taking of right-of-way by County Road No. 4.

Field Supervisor was L. E. Monrean. Equipment used was a RED-1, a DKM2AE Theodolite, and supporting equipment.

Basis of bearing was the alignment of the centerline of County road No. 4.
