P. fir snag approx. 45 feet tall bears S48°W, 21 1/2 feet distant (as per record); tree has blaze scars, an "X" blaze in the bark on the northeast side, and is bark scribed T30 R4W S36 BT. An original Red Fir 8 ins. diam, now a 10 inch diameter, 30 inch tall rolled fir stump bears N46 1/2°W, 22 1/4 feet distant (as per record)

stump has old axe work, no scribing found.

From renewal #175 a 14" R. Fir now a 14 inch DBH, D. fir snag approx. 12 feet tall bears N 01° W, 40[±] feet distant (as per record) tree has unhealed double blaze marked T30S R4W/S25 CS BT (record S25 T30S R4W CS BT)

Monument Set: (Procedure and Description) Monument position is accepted.

New Accessories: (Description) A 6 inch D.B.H. Douglas fir bears S 51 1/2° W, 31[±] feet distant, and is scribed T30S R4W S36 CS BT on a double blaze. A 7 inch DBH. Douglas fir bears S ~~67~~⁶⁵° W, 61[±] feet distant and is scribed T30S R4W S36 CS BT on a double blaze. The tree from renewal #175 and the new bearing trees are tagged with DCSO BT tags.
