ORIGINAL MONUMENT NOT FOUND.

FOUND A WOODEN POST TEMPORARILY MARKING CORNER POSITION. POST HAS BEEN RECENTLY SET WITH TEMPORARY MARKS ON HEWN SIDES.

Accessories Found:

A FIR STUMP ABOUT 6 FEET HIGH AND 4 1/2 INCHES DIAMETER BEARS N 12° E 48 1/2 FEET. THIS STUMP HAS TWO BEARING TREE TAGS, ONE IS DATED 4-17-84, THE OLDER TAG IS DATED 8-31-62 WITH INITIALS RY, THIS IS A BLM TAG. THIS STUMP HAS SEVERAL SCARS. BEFORE OPENING THIS STUMP WE LOOKED FOR EVIDENCE OF BARK SCRIBING, NONE WAS FOUND. WE OPENED THE STUMP OVER A LARGE AREA FACING THE NOTED POST, NO EVIDENCE OF A BLAZE OR SCRIBING WAS FOUND. TWO AXE NOTCHES WERE FOUND ABOUT 2 FEET ABOVE GROUND, LEVEL WITH EACH OTHER AND ABOUT 1 1/2 FEET APART. 20 1/2 GROWTH RINGS WERE COUNTED IN THE GOOD WOOD COVERING THESE NOTCHES, ANOTHER LAYER OF DECAYED WOOD IS LOCATED UNDER THE BARK ABOUT 25 GROWTH RINGS WERE COUNTED IN THIS LAYER. THIS WOULD PLACE THE DATE OF THE NOTCHES AT ABOUT 45 YEARS PRIOR TO THE DATE THE TREE WAS CUT DOWN. THIS AREA APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN LOGGED 20 TO 25 YEARS (APPROX) PRIOR TO MY VISIT. THIS WOULD DATE THE AGE OF THE AXE MARKS AT ABOUT 65 TO 70 YEARS. THE ORIGINAL SURVEY WAS DONE IN 1899.

DECAYED AND BROKEN REMAINS OF A TREE (SIZE INDETERMINABLE) WERE FOUND S 18° W 13 1/2 FEET FROM THE FOUND TEMPORARY POST.
