POSSIBLE ORIGINAL SW BEARING TREE: A 30 INCH D.B.H. BLACK OAK (ORIGINALLY A 15 INCH Y. OAK) BEARS S28°W, 31.5 FT DIST. TO BROKEN FACE (ORIGINALLY S28°W, 31.2 FT DIST) TREE IS ALIVE, FACE TOWARD CORNER IS BROKEN AWAY, BLAZING AND SCRIBING GONE, ORIGINAL DISTANCE MAY HAVE FIT TO BROKEN AWAY FACE.

FROM RENEWAL #4 A 26 INCH DIA. BLACK OAK NOW A 35 INCH D.B.H. BLACK OAK BEARS N83°W, 13.2 FT. DIST. (AS PER RECORD) TREE HAS OPENED AND PARTIALLY RE-HEALED BLAZE, NO SCRIBING VISIBLE, AND A 28 INCH DIA. WHITE OAK NOW A 37 INCH D.B.H. WHITE OAK BEARS S02°W 55.2 FT DIST. (RECORD S02°W 56.2 FT DIST.) TREE HAS SINGLE WELL HEALED BLAZE.

FROM RENEWAL #118 THE NE TREBLE W. OAK IS GONE (REMOVED DURING HOUSE CONSTRUCTION.)

A 9 INCH W. OAK NOW A 14 INCH D.B.H. W. OAK BEARS S57°E, 35.5 FT DIST. (AS PER RECORD) TREE HAS WELL HEALED DOUBLE BLAZE, NO SCRIBING VISIBLE.

FROM RENEWAL #145 A 3WAY FENCE CORNER NOW A TWO WAY FENCE CORNER WITH FENCES RUNNING SOUTH AND WEST BEARS SW 0.9 FT DIST.
