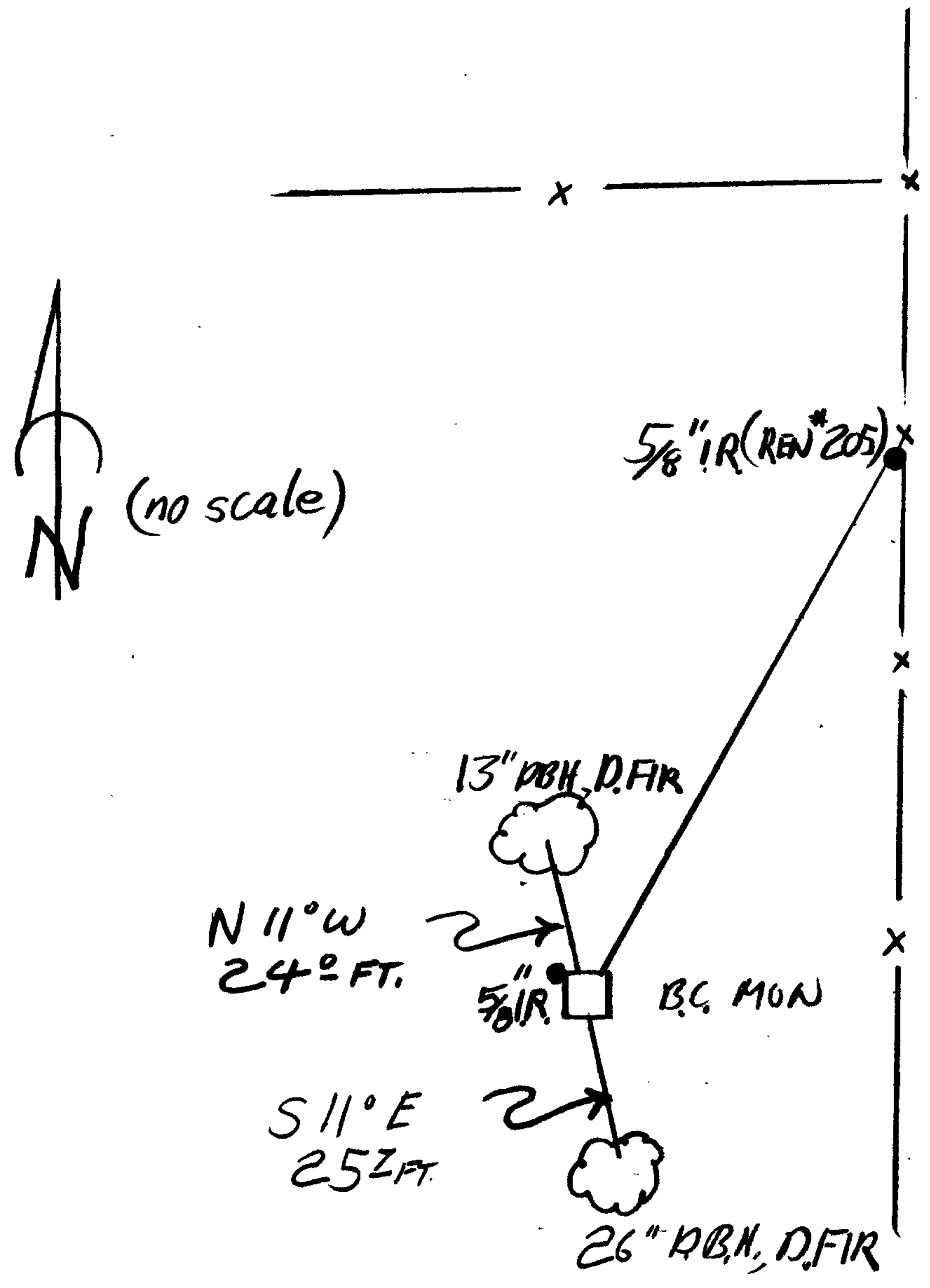
Monument Detail

AN ERROR IN DECLINATION IS APPARENTLY REPEATED IN MEASUREMENT TO THE BEARING TREES IN RENEWALS # 200 & 205.
