A 2 1/2" BRASS CAP MARKED AS AT RIGHT ON A 1 1/4" O.D. IRON PIPE FIRMLY SET AND PROTRUDING 4 INCHES ABOVE GROUND.

HAINES T-IRON (FOUND IN RENEWAL #100 OTHERWISE UNRECORDED) BURIED UNDER FALLEN LOG IS BENT SLIGHTLY AND LEANING SOUTHEAST 0 3/4 FT. FROM BRASS CAP POSITION.

NO EVIDENCE OF ORIGINAL POST AND STONE FOUND.

3 ORIGINAL BEARING TREES FOUND; NO EVIDENCE OF SOUTHWEST ORIGINAL BEARING TREE FOUND. AN ORIGINAL FIR, 9 INS. DIA. NOW A D. FIR 47 INCHES D.B.H. WITH A PREVIOUSLY OPENED NOW FULLY REHEALED SINGLE BLAZE BEARS N 64° E, 29.0 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD). AN ORIGINAL FIR 10 INS. DIA. NOW A D. FIR 48 INCHES D.B.H. WITH A PREVIOUSLY RESCRIBED NOW FULLY REHEALED SINGLE BLAZE BEARS N 74° E, 28.4 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD). POSSIBLE EVIDENCE OF AN ORIGINAL FIR, 48 INS. DIA. NOW A ROTTED FIR SNAG 37 INCH D.B.H., 25 FEET TALL PREVIOUSLY OPENED BUT WITH NO EVIDENCE OF BLAZE OR SCRIBING BEARS N 21° W, 20.2 FEET DISTANT (RECORD N 20° W, 18.2 FT. DIST.)

FROM RENEWAL #100, 3 BEARING TREES FOUND. A 30" D. FIR. NOW A D. FIR, 33 INCH D.B.H., WITH A FULLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE BEARS N 80° E, 36.8 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD). A 12" D. FIR NOW A D. FIR, 16 INCH D.B.H. FALLEN ROTTING AND OUT OF POSITION WITH A PARTIALLY HEALED BUT ROTTED DOUBLE BLAZE CONTAINING SOME EVIDENCE OF PARTIAL BUT ILLEGIBLE SCRIBING; INDISTINCT ROOT-HOLE OF THIS TREE IS NEAR RECORD BEARING AND DISTANCE. A 25" D. FIR NOW A D. FIR 30 INCH D.B.H. WITH A FULLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE N 3 1/2° W, 62.3 FEET DISTANT (RECORD N 1° W, 64.3 FT.; DISTANCE CHECKS WELL AS A SLOPE DISTANCE).

AN UNRECORDED ALDER WITH A 1979 B.T. TAG POSSIBLY SIGNED JEJ IS 20 INCHES D.B.H. BARK SCRIBED T215 R6W S8 BT AND BEARS S 30° E, 19.4 FEET DISTANT (B.T. TAG RECORDS S 29° E, 29 WKS.)

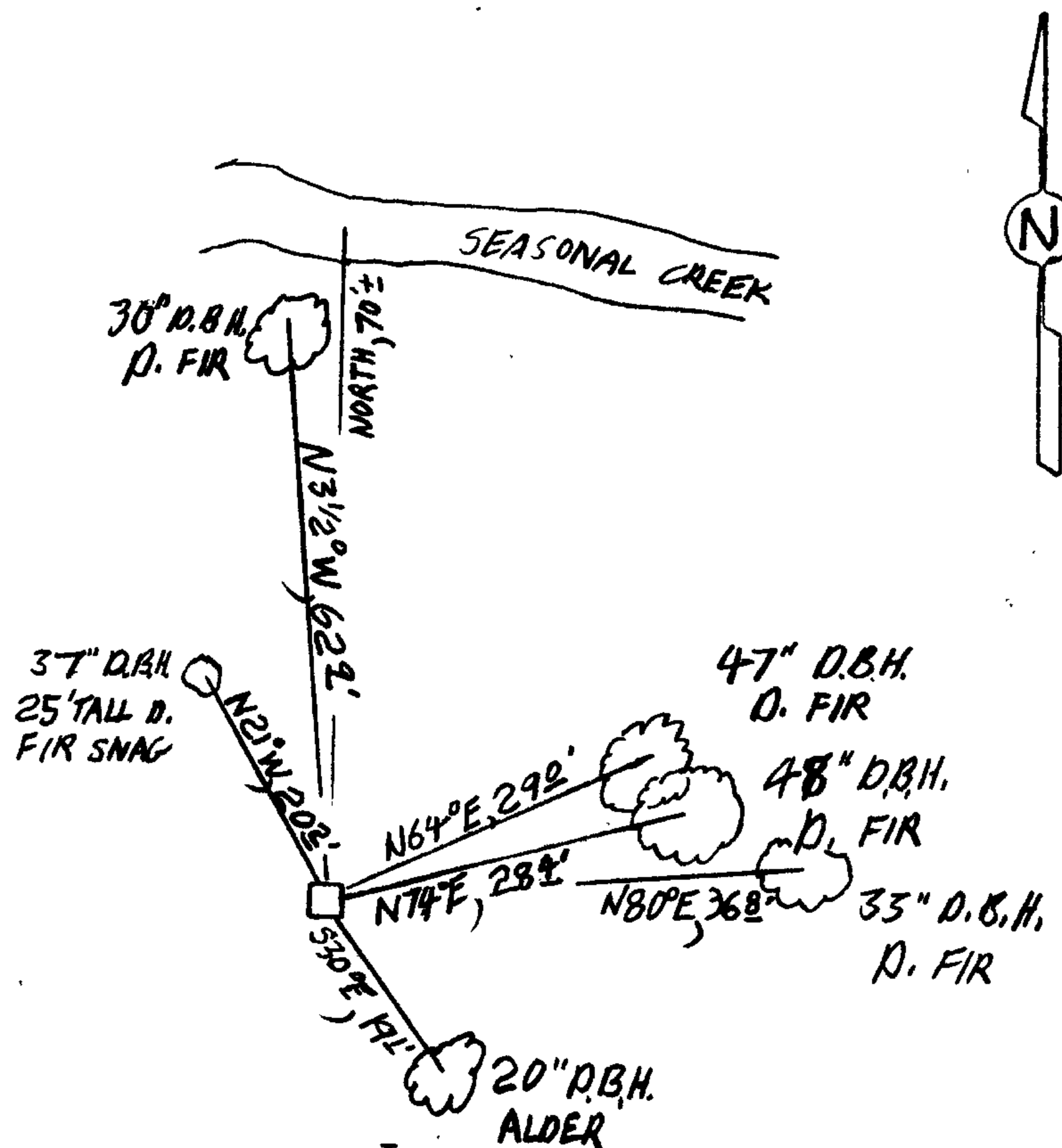

MONUMENT LIES AT FOOT OF SOUTHERLY SLOPE OF STEEP WALLED FLAT BOTTOMED DRAW; AND IS APPROX. 70 FEET SOUTH OF SEASONAL CREEK IN DRAW AND IS APPROX. 200 FEET SOUTHEAST FROM CONFLUENCE OF CREEK IN DRAW AND CREEK IN MAIN CANYON COURSING SOUTHWEST.
