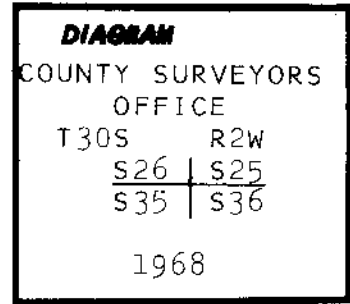

- A 16" FIR BEARS N59°W 73.5 FEET, SCAR VISIBLE.
- A 12" PINE BEARS S74°E 33.4 FEET, SCAR VISIBLE.
- A 16" FIR BEARS S03°E 20.9 FEET, SCAR VISIBLE.
- A 38" FIR BEARS N50°E 9.0 FEET, NO SCAR.
- A 16" FIR BEARS S43°W 39.5 FEET, SCRIBE VISIBLE.
