

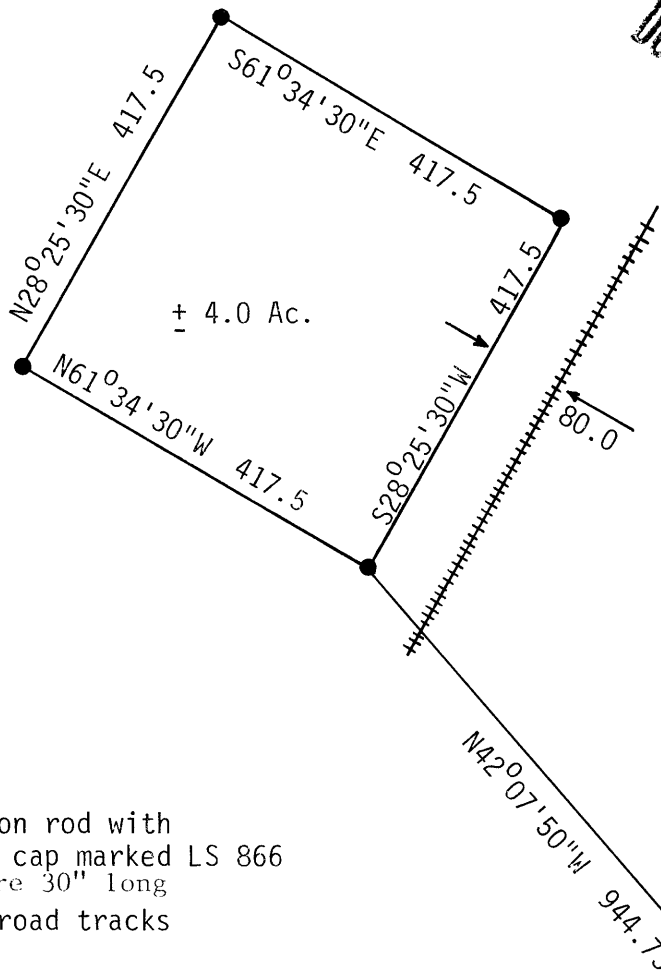

PARCEL DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land in Section 13, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron rod which is North  $42^{\circ}07'50''$  West 944.73 feet from the northeast corner of Vandebosch DLC No.47, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian; thence from the point of beginning North  $61^{\circ}34'30''$  West 417.5 feet to a 5/8" iron rod; thence North  $28^{\circ}25'30''$  East 417.5 feet to a 5/8" iron rod; thence South  $61^{\circ}34'30''$  East 417.5 feet to a 5/8" iron rod which is 80 feet northwesterly from the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks; thence parallel to and 80 feet northwesterly from said railroad tracks South  $28^{\circ}25'30''$  West 417.5 feet to the point of beginning, containing 4.0 acres more or less.
