NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey is to locate the center line of the Umpqua Highway at Hayhurst Road for widening the highway. Additional right-of-way width was purchased from both sides of the highway as indicated.

The center line was reestablished from existing found pins at station 1754+22 and 1767+93.8. The actual measured distance between each set of monuments checked out very close to record distance.

This survey found and tied the NW corner, and the west 1/4 corner of S18,T22S,R5W, and also the NW corner of T. Stillwell Donation Land Claim 45.

The Section Corner was renewed or perpetuated in the same location from original B.T.'s in 1959 and the 1/4 corner was renewed in 1976. The Donation Land Claim corner is a 6" x 6" stone with an "X" mark on top. We found the same stone as was found in 1952, Elk Creek Home-sites platted survey. However, the county surveyors office has no record of any renewals or reestablishments for this corner and the stone does not match what is shown on the original field notes for this Donation Land Claim. Therefore, the monument is suspect.

The basis of bearing was obtained from solar observations. The bearing thus established disagrees with the bearing per right-of-way map of 1929, No. 1B-20-16 by approximately 0°17'.

This survey was conducted in the following areas:

- SE 1/4 section 12T22S, R6W.W.M.
- NE 1/4 section 13T22S, R6W.W.M.
- NW 1/4, NE 1/4 section 18,T22S,R5W.W.M.
