OUR RECORD

The single remaining original bearing tree, mkd. by C. Campbell in
1902, a douglas fir, now 54 ins. diam., containing scribe mks.
including "S, 2 & W" in partly exposed face, brs. record; S73°W, 25.08
ft. to center of tree at base. Note: The original stone could not be
found.

Bearing trees mkd. on the above noted survey:

Douglas Fir, 32 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. N30°E,
67.95 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; 66.8 ft.

White Fir, 9 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. N79°W,

11.95 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; 11.5 ft.

Mk new trees "CS" "BT" and take measurements to center of trees at
lower blaze:

White Fir, 9 ins. diam., brs. S36°E, 15.70 ft.

Douglas Fir, 7 ins. diam., brs. S46½°W, 22.10 ft.

Corner lies about 150 ft. S25°E of old Richter cabin.
