W.M., Found:

Original Monument: C.S. file 51/61

1 1/2" iron pipe slightly bent to the north and 8"
underground.

Original Bearing Trees: C.S. file 51/61

17" Douglas-fir N 25° 10' E, 129.1', healed face,
now 22" DBH

18" Spruce S 0° 45' W, 133.0', now a stump
partially washed out by creek.

New Monument:

I place a 2" brass cap in existing monument,
stamped: T22S R12W CE 1/16 LS 2052 S28 1989.
I place a steel fence post on west side of
monument.

New Bearing Trees:

53" Spruce bears S 6° W, 135.98', scribed C 1/16
BT. Measurements taken to spike in base. This
tree leans toward corner and is South of creek.

8" Power Pole #9B-5A bears S 52° W, 96.84' to
center of pole.
