Dear Mr. Ingram:

I am forwarding to you, for your information, the enclosed copies of a portion of field book #210 from our James L. McPherson collection. I believe these notes relate to a portion of T31S, R6W.

McPherson was a Deputy Surveyor and Deputy Mineral Surveyor in Washington. He also did a lot of private work. We have 120 of his books, most of which relate to Washington and Alaska. We have tried to index them, but it has been difficult due to his failure to consistently identify his work by township and range.

For instance, on page 33 he describes a section corner and labels it T31S but doesn't identify the range. However, the latitude and longitude shown on page 23, together with the name, Silver Peak Mine, cause me to believe this work is located in R6W, near Silver Butte.

Hopefully these notes will be of value to surveyors in your area.
