NARRATIVE FOR A SURVEY TO SET C1/4  
SEC. 10, T22S, R5W, W.M.

COUNTY SURVEYOR  
DOUGLAS COUNTY, ORE.

THIS IS A NARRATIVE REFERRING TO A FEBRUARY 1991 SURVEY PLAT FILED WITH THE DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE ENTITLED, "SURVEY TO SET C1/4 SEC. 10, T22S, R5W, W.M., DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON, FEBRUARY 1991, BY CHAMPION INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION".

THE SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED TO SET THE C1/4, SEC. 10, T22S, R5W, W.M. FOR CHAMPION INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION. IN ADDITION, THE POSITION OF THE E1/16 CORNER BETWEEN SEC. 10 AND SEC. 3 WAS VERIFIED. BASIS OF BEARING WAS OBTAINED FROM THE BEARING BETWEEN THE W1/4 AND E1/4, SEC. 10 (S89 42'E), ESTABLISHED IN A 1952 SURVEY BY MCGILlicUDDY, FILED RM 1-40.

THE NORTH LINE OF SEC. 10 WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED BY W. P. WRIGHT, IN 1884. THE NE SECTION CORNER, SEC. 10, WAS SET BY MCGILlicUDDY IN 1952 BASED ON ORIGINAL EVIDENCE FOUND. THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE REPLACED THE NE CORNER MONUMENT IN 1958. THE 1/4 AND E1/16 CORNERS BETWEEN SEC. 10 AND 3, WERE SET AT PROPORTIONAL DISTANCE BY MCLIND IN 1973 (SEE SURVEY FILED M48-78).

THE W1/4 CORNER, AND ITS ORIGINAL ACCESSORIES, WERE FOUND BY MCGILlicUDDY IN 1952. SOURCE OF THE MONUMENT FOUND IS UNKNOWN. THE E1/4 CORNER WAS SET BY MCGILlicUDDY IN 1952, BASED ON ORIGINAL EVIDENCE FOUND. SHANER REPLACED THE E1/4 MONUMENT IN 1972. THE S1/4 CORNER WAS SET AT PROPORTIONAL DISTANCE BY MCGILlicUDDY IN 1952 (SEE SURVEY FILED RM 1-40).

THE C1/4 CORNER, SEC. 10, WAS SET AT THE INTERSECTION OF LINES RUNNING FROM OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS.

ALL TRAVERSES RUN WERE CLOSED LOOPS WITH A MINIMUM ERROR OF CLOSURE OF ONE PART IN 40,000. PROPERTY LINE WERE POSTED WITH FIVE FOOT STEEL FENCE POSTS, WITH ATTACHED "CHAMPION" SIGNS. LINE WAS ALSO BLAZED AND FLAGGED.
