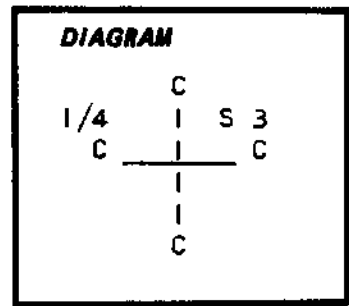


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Section 3 was subdivided by G. Baughman in 1972, which is when this corner was established.



Description of corner evidence found:

2" iron pipe with 3" brass cap 3" above ground marked

8" Madrone N92°W, 20.6 ft, healed blazes

10" Knobcone pine S60°E, 7.4 ft, (dead) scribes partially visible
