Dear Bruce:

This is in reply to your inquiry, by FAX message today, concerning the line between sections 3 and 34, Tps. 30 and 31 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The advice that we gave in our letter, dated December 23, 1981, is still applicable. Despite the fact that in his field note record Bushy called the point between sections 3 and 34 a 1/4 corner, this point is merely an angle point on the township boundary. The manner in which the areas were returned in sections 3 and 34 on Bushy's plats indicates that the 1/4 section corners should be established at midpoint between the respective closing corners for each section.

Dear Ms. Laugen:

This is in response to your letter dated December 10, 1981, concerning the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner of sections 3 and 34, on the south boundary of T. 30 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, reestablished by William Theil, in 1889.

This point is not a  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner for either section, it is an angle point on the township boundary. To protect the loffings and areas in sections 3 and 34, it would be necessary to establish two  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corners, both at midpoint between the controlling closing corners, established by Bushey, in 1893-94.

We hope this information is helpful to you.

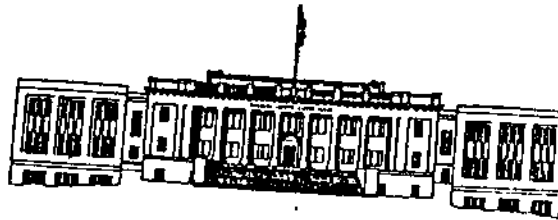

A renewal by Markham and again by Byron say it is not a 1/4 corner.

Our crew (on the request of the local BLM office) are preparing to renew the corner from existing evidence but are unsure of what to stamp on the cap.

Is it an angle point on line or Witness Point or ?

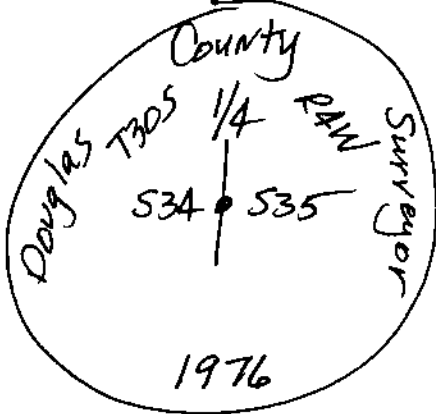
