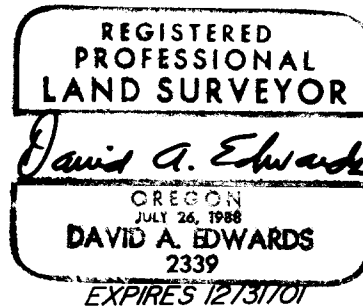

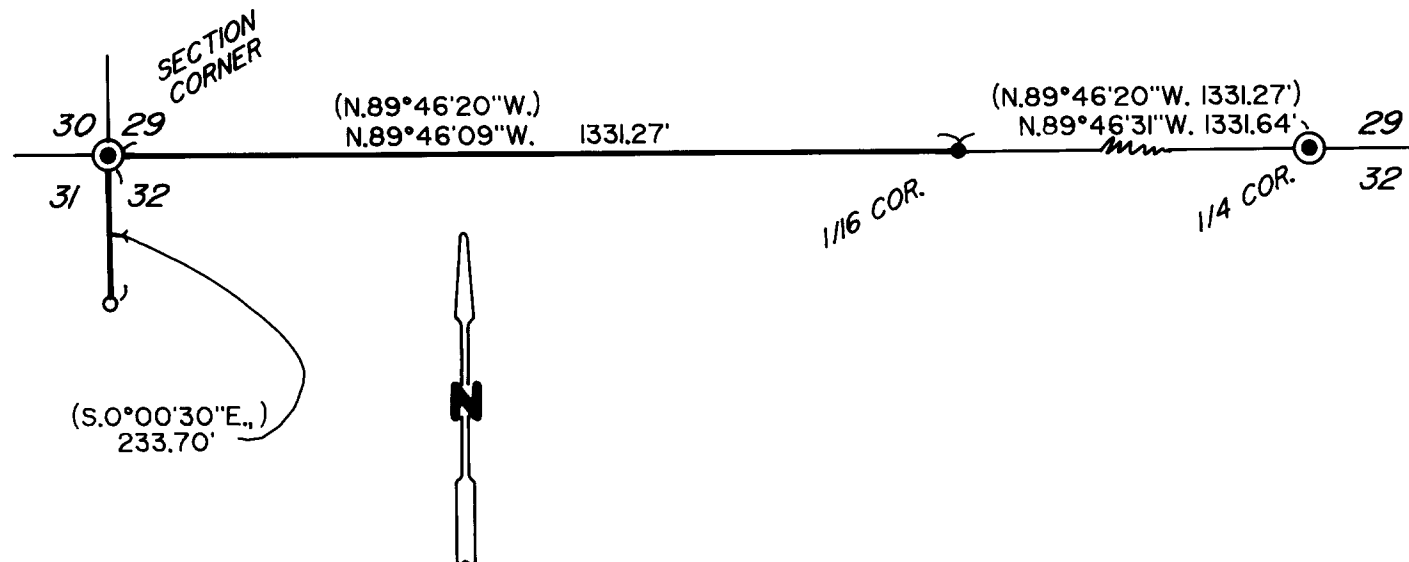

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO CHECK THE ACCURACY OF SURVEY WORK ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 32 AS PERFORMED ON SURVEY M 134-76. A CONTROL TRAVERSE WAS EXECUTED WHICH TIED THE THE THREE FOUND MONUMENTS SHOWN HEREON TOGETHER. THE STAKES AND BLAZES FOUND ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THE NW 1/4 OF THE NW 1/4 WERE FOUND TO BE ACCURATE. THE WITNESS MONUMENT WAS THEN ESTABLISHED AS SHOWN HEREON.
