Southeast Corner for Section 20: Found 1945 Brass Cap on Iron Pipe firmly set on South edge of existing road with 6 foot aluminum post alongside with top painted red.

Old Bearing Trees Taken in 1945 by GLO:

40" dead Fir, N 58 ½ ° E, 42 links is gone due to existing road.

18" Hemlock, S 4° E, 162 links this is a 42" Fir with old and new healed faces (see M101-63). This was erroneously called a Hemlock by GLO.

32" D. Fir, S 29° W, 263 links is now 38" with healed face

20" dead Fir, N 14° W, 42 links is now a burnt and rotting stump

Raised Mound of Stone is gone

Old Bearing Trees Taken in 1985 by Bentz:

10" D. Fir, N 70° E (record N 60° E), 57.5 ft. with healed face and aluminum tag.

15" D. Fir, N 5° W (record N 20° W), 19.0 ft. with scribe visible and aluminum tag.

8" Madrone, S 83° W, 39.2 ft. with scribe visible and aluminum tag.

42" D. Fir, S 5° E, 106.4 ft. with healed face aluminum tag. This is the 1945 GLO bearing tree (see above note).

New Bearing Trees Taken This Survey:

10" D. Fir, N 26° E, 26.0 feet to spike set side center, scribed "T21 R8 S21 BT" with aluminum tag.
