

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Malcolm M. Clark under Survey M 82-68 and associated narrative

CS 58/227, dated March 12, 1980:

8" Hemlock S.76°10'W 44.0' scribed "T32S R3W C 1/4 S20 BT"

Note: All new BT's also marked with a 3/4" brass disc stamped "RLS 601" on the lower blaze."

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2 1/2" dia. aluminum post, firmly set, projecting 8" above the ground with a 2 1/2" dia. aluminum cap stamped:

T 32 S R 3 W

C 1/4 S 20

1980

RLS 601

From which bearing trees by Clark in 1980:

A 13" Hemlock bears S.76°10'W., 44.0 ft. with a healed double blaze. (Rec. S.76°10'W.)

A 14" Hemlock snag with broken top bears N.35°10'W., 49.4 ft. with scribe marks "T32S R3W C 1/4 S20 BT" visible on a partially healed double blaze. (Rec. N.35°10'W.)

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I scribed a new bearing tree:

A 9" D. fir bears S.66°E., 9.9 ft. scribed "C 1/4 S20 BT".

All new bearing trees have double blazed faces with a brass washer stamped "PLS 1941" nailed into the lower blaze. Bearings are taken to the center of the tree at the root crown and distances are measured to an aluminum nail in the root crown at the side and center of the tree. All bearing trees have a 6" red band painted around the tree and the blazed face painted red and Bearing Tree and USFS Land Survey Monument sign nailed to the tree.
