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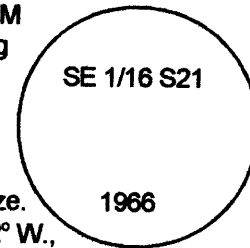

Renewal of SE One-Sixteenth Corner of Section 21, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

Corner Evidence Found:

December 12, 2012

I found an iron post and a brass cap established in 1966 by John M. Jelly, BLM Cadastral Surveyor. The iron post is 2-1/2 inch diameter, firmly set, projecting 6 inches above ground, with 3-1/8 inch diameter BLM Cadastral brass cap attached and marked as shown.



From which bearing trees marked by Jelley in 1966:

- A 28" Douglas fir, bears N. 58° E., 57.7 feet, with a healed single blaze.
- An 8" madrone snag, bears S. 15° 30' W., 23.7 feet (record S. 17-1/2° W., 36-1/2 links = 24.09 feet), with a healed single blaze.

Perpetuation of Corner:

December 12, 2012

I marked a new bearing tree:

- A 12' Douglas fir, bears S. 27° E., 12.3 feet, scribed "SE 1/16 S21 BT" with a 1/2 inch diameter brass washer stamped "LS 2150" nailed flush to the base of the single blaze.

With a Lietz optical transit I back sighted westerly down the blazed section subdivision line, which has a platted bearing of N. 89° 13' W., as my basis of bearings. Bearings are reported to the nearest 15 minutes. Trees are measured to the center of the root crown. Tree diameters are at breast height.
