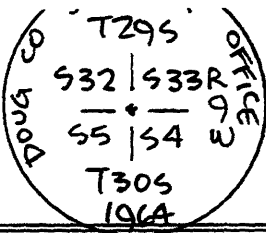

Found 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" iron pipe, 0.8' tall, in good condition, somewhat loose in the ground, but will not pull out. We set a Douglas Fir limb post 3' North and paint the top in blue.

Found a 19" Hemlock stub, S72°E, 22.59' to right side center. We find an open face with scribes visible and a BLM tag in place. We paint the face in blue. FAIR

Found a 56" Douglas Fir stump, S45°W, 9.55' to heart center. We find a chopped out face with no visible marks but a BLM tag in place. We paint the face in blue. FAIR

Found a 36" Hemlock stump, N70°W, 26.31' to heart center. We find axe marks with scribes visible on reverse piece of wood and a BLM tag in place. We paint the face in blue. POOR CONDITION

Found a 30" Douglas Fir stump, N62°30'E, 38.19' to heart center. We find an open face with scribes visible. We paint the face in blue. POOR CONDITION

Found an 18" Hemlock, S25°W, 25.45' to left side center. We find a headed blaze and a BLM tag in place. We paint the face and a band around the tree in blue. Tree leans to left and has some damage but overall GOOD COND.						
New BT						
A 28" Douglas Fir, N32°30'W, 18.11' to a nail at left side center. We blaze and scribe "T29 R9 S32 BT". We paint the scribes and a band around the tree in blue and attach a yellow Coos County tag.						
New BT						
An 11" Douglas Fir, N54°30'E, 10.46' to a nail at right side center. We blaze and scribe "T29 R9 S33 BT". We paint the scribes and a band around the tree in blue and attach a yellow Coos County tag.						
New BT						
A 20" Douglas Fir, S73°E, 5.21' to a nail at left side center. We blaze and scribe "T30 R9 S4 BT". We paint the scribes and a band around the tree in blue and attach a yellow Coos County tag.
