Old Monument Powell 1967 Book 12, Pg. 07, 08

Found $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on a $1\frac{1}{4}$ " o.d. iron pipe, 1.0' tall, in good condition and solid in the ground, leaning slightly to the South. We find a 1" iron pipe, 2.05' tall, of unknown origin, found by Powell in 1967, $S78^{\circ}E+0.35'$. We set a Douglas Fir post 2' North and paint the top in blue. There is a broken off wood post 1' North of the BCIP.

Old BT Byars 1900 G47, Pg. 09

Found a 35" White Cedar snag, 30' tall, $N45^{\circ}15'W$, 149.44' to left side center. We find visible scribes and a 1958 BLM tag in place. We paint the face and a band around the snag in blue. Snag falls near an old logging road. **GOOD CONDITION**

Old BT Byars 1900 G47, Pg. 09

Found a 17" White Cedar, $N52^{\circ}30'E$, 14.58' to right side center. We find a healed blaze but no tag. We paint the blaze and a band around the tree in blue and attach a new yellow tag. **GOOD CONDITION**

Old BT Laush tag 1950 unrecorded

Found a 15" Douglas Fir with top broken and touching the ground, yet still attached to the main stem, $N85^{\circ}E$, 10.69' to left side center. There is a healed scar on the right side. We paint the scar and a band around the tree in blue. **FAIR CONDITION**

New BT

A 9" Douglas Fir, $S35^{\circ}W$, 33.37' to a nail at right side center. We blaze and scribe " $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT". We paint the blaze, scribes and a band around the tree in blue and attach a yellow Coos County tag.

New BT

A 7" Douglas Fir, $N41^{\circ}W$, 27.96' to a nail at left side center. We blaze and scribe " $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT". We paint the blaze, scribes and a band around the tree in blue and attach a yellow Coos County tag.

New BT

A 4" Douglas Fir, $S44^{\circ}E$, 25.65' to a nail at left side center. We chop a notch low and scribe an "X" high. We paint the notch, "X" and a band around the tree in blue and attach a yellow Coos County tag.
