FROM 1959 GLO RESURVEY A 2 1/2 INCH DIAMETER BRASS CAP (MARKED AS AT RIGHT) ON A 1 INCH OD. IRON PIPE FIRMLY SET AND PROTRUDING APPROXIMATELY 12 INCHES ABOVE GROUND IN AN EAST-WEST FENCE LINE. (THIS CAP WAS MOVED FROM THE POSITION ESTABLISHED IN THE 1957 BLM RESURVEY.)

NO EVIDENCE OF ORIGINAL BEARING TREES FOUND

FROM 1957 BLM RESURVEY; FOUND TWO TREES WHICH WERE PROBABLY STANDING AND USED IN SUBSEQUENT 1959 BLM RESURVEY (THESE TREES ARE DESCRIBED IN NEXT ENTRY). EVIDENCE INDICATES THE BEARING RECORDED TO 1957 NE 1ST SHOULD BE NW.

FROM 1959 BLM RESURVEY; TWO BEARING TREES FOUND (SEE ABOVE). A FIR 6" DIAM. NOW A 21 INCH DBH DOUGLAS FIR WITH A FULLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE BEARS N11°E, 77 1/2 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).

A FIR 14" DIAM (THIS SIZE MAY BE IN ERROR; LOCATION EVIDENCE INDICATES THIS IS THE 18" DIAM. FIR FROM THE 1957 BLM RESURVEY) NOW A 25 INCH D.B.H. DOUGLAS FIR WITH A FULLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE BEARS S23 1/2° W, 55 1/2 FEET DISTANT (RECORD S20°E, 55 1/2 FEET).
