EVIDENCE OF ONE ORIGINAL BEARING TREE FOUND. A B. OAK 8" DIA., NOW A SHALLOW BUT DISTINCT ROOT DEPRESSION; BEARS S45°E, 7 1/2 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).

EVIDENCE OF ONE 1967/69 B.T. FOUND. AN OAK 28" DIA. NOW A PARTIALLY ROTTEN 22 INCH DIAMETER 3 FOOT TALL WHITE OAK STUMP WITH A FULLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE; BEARS S70 1/4°W, 10 1/2 FEET DISTANT (RECORD S81 1/2°W, 11 1/2 FEET).

EVIDENCE OF THE TWO 1990/91 RENEWAL B.T.'S FOUND. A MADRONE, 7 INS. DIAM. NOW A 6 INCH DIAMETER 3 1/2 FOOT LONG PIECE OF MADRONE TRUNK WITH A BEARING TREE TAG ATTACHED IS FOUND LOOSE ON GROUND SURFACE NEAR TO RECORD BEARING AND DISTANCE.

AN OAK 1 1/2 INS. DIAM. NOW A 19 INCH DIAMETER WHITE OAK WITH A FULLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE; BEARS N75 3/4°W, 27 1/2 FEET DISTANT (RECORD N74 1/2°W, 27 1/2 FEET).
