FROM THE 1979 RENEWAL A 2 1/2" DIAMETER BRASS CAP (MARKED AS AT RIGHT) ON A 1 INCH I.D. IRON PIPE, FIRMLY AND PLUMBLY SET, PROTRUDING 3 INCHES ABOVE GROUND.  
FROM THE 1939 RENEWAL A 3/4" IRON PIPE (OF UNKNOWN ORIGIN) LATER CORRECTLY IDENTIFIED AS A 1 INCH (I.D.) IRON PIPE IS SET ON THE WEST EDGE OF THE FOUND B.C. MONUMENT PROTRUDING 3 INCHES ABOVE GROUND.

POSSIBLE EVIDENCE OF ONE O.B.T. FOUND.  
A VERY LARGE IRREGULAR ROOT-HOLE WITH A SMALL LIVE MADRONE TRUNK GROWING FROM REMAINING FRAGMENT OF OLD MADRONE TRUNK. THE NEAR CENTER OF THIS ROOT-HOLE BEARS N25°W, 27 1/2 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).

FROM THE 1939 RENEWAL EVIDENCE OF THE TWO RENEWAL TREES.  
A 12" FIR NOW A ROTTED TO GROUND AND BROKEN APART, DOUGLAS FIR STUMP WITH PARTS OF HEALED BLAZE EDGES NEARBY; BEARS N29 1/2°E, 42° FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).  
A 4" LAUREL NOW A DEAD BUT STILL INTACT 15 INCH DIAMETER MADRONE WITH A PARTIALLY HEALED SINGLE BLAZE, SCRIBING NO LONGER VISIBLE; BEARS S54°W, 18 1/2 FEET DISTANT (RECORD S50°W, 18 FT BUT 1979 DISTANCE IS 18 1/2 FT).

EVIDENCE OF THE 1959 RENEWAL BEARING TREE.  
AN 8" B. OAK NOW A DEAD AND FALLEN (PARTIALLY CUT UP) 13 INCH DIAMETER BLACK OAK WITH A FULLY HEALED DOUBLE BLAZE; THE ROOT-HOLE OF WHICH BEARS S54 1/2°E, 31 1/2 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).

EVIDENCE OF THREE 1979 RENEWAL B.T.'s. A 9" FIR NOW A 1 1/4 INCH DIAMETER 7 1/2 FOOT TALL DOUGLAS FIR STUMP WITH A FULLY HEALED DOUBLE BLAZE; BEARS N46°E, 41 1/2 FEET DISTANT (AS PER REC.)  
A 15" FIR NOW A 24 INCH DIAMETER 4 FOOT TALL DOUGLAS FIR STUMP WITH A FULLY HEALED DOUBLE BLAZE; BEARS N43 1/2°W, 40 3/4 FEET DISTANT (AS PER RECORD).  
A 9" FIR NOW A TALL DEAD 17 INCH DIAMETER DOUGLAS FIR WITH A FULLY HEALED DOUBLE BLAZE; BEARS S37 1/4°W, 31 1/2 FEET DISTANT (RECORD S36°W, 31 1/2 FT.).
