A FIR 12" DIA. NOW A FALLEN, ROTTED AND SPLIT OPEN 32 INCH DIAM. DOUGLAS FIR SHOWING AN  
INTACT FACE WITH A CHAINING NOTCH AND THE SCRIBING "BT". THE ROTTED AND BROKEN STUMP OF  
THIS TREE BEARS N28°E, 48.8 FEET (AS PER RECORD).  
NO EVIDENCE REMAINS OF SOUTHWEST O.B.T.
