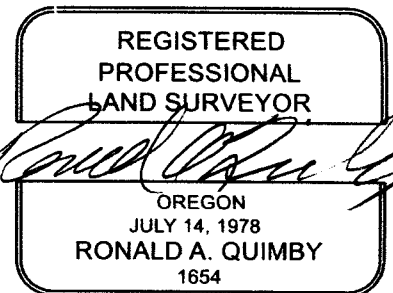

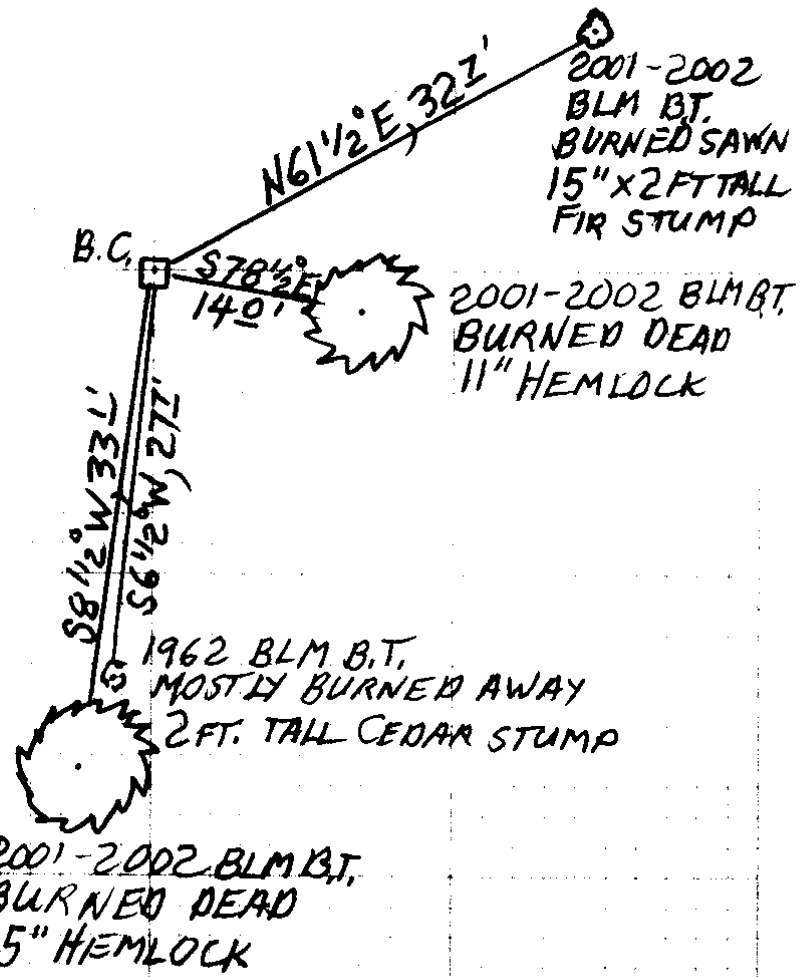

A hemlock stump, 18" dia., bears S.25°E., 42.6 ft., with healed blaze. (Record, 38.9 ft.)

A roothole, bears S.19°W, 9V2 ft., with sawed & decayed hemlock stump pushed over alongside, no marks visible. *GONE*

A fallen hemlock, 32" dia., bears N.38°W., 10.5 ft., with no marks visible on partially healed blaze. (Record, N.28°W.)

A sawed cedar stump, 34" dia., bears S.6½°W., 27.7 ft., with scribe marks BT visible on partially healed blaze. and new bearing trees

A fir, 6" dia., bears N.62¼°E., 32.6 ft., mkd. T25S R2W S24 BT. *6 1/2 32 7 TOP CNTR, 3 1/2" PK*  
*LOWER PART OF BLZ. VISIBLE AT 6" DIAM.*

A hemlock, 5" dia., bears S.75°E., 14.2 ft., mkd. T25S R2W S25 BT. *BLZ PARTLY HEALED MOSTLY BURNED FAC. SOME PARTIAL SCRIBING*

A hemlock, 7" dia., bears S.11½°W., 32.8 ft., mkd. T25S R2W S26 BT. *PART HEALED 8 1/2 33 L FACE BURNED AWAY*

*ST 8 1/2 E, 140*  
*3 1/2 PK RSC*  
*BRASS WASH IN FACE*

Each new bearing tree has a 2½" x ¼" magnetic nail (Mag Nail) driven at the base right side-center. *THESE WERE NOT AD.*  
 From this point, National Geodetic Survey station "STEAM. 1989" bears S.75°20'40"E., 42,789.90 ft. (mean bearing & sea level), monumented with a brass disk set in concrete, buried 8 ins. below surface of parking area, in a monument well, mkd. OREGON PRIMARY GPS STATION STEAM 1989 and a triangle.

*MONUMENT IS APPROX. 60' WEST FROM N-S RUNNING GRAVEL RD.*
