DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYOR

Now at this time comes on to be heard the petition of S. C. Miller, - and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that said S. C. Miller is the owner of the premises described in the said petition and that there are no persons to be particularly affected by the vacation of the lots, blocks, streets and alley and commons hereinafter vacated; and that proper notice has been given as by law required by posting in three public places in the town of Dillard Douglas County Oregon notices of the application of said vacation by firmly nailing one of said notices duly certified to by G. W. Benson County Clerk of Douglas County State of Oregon on the front of the store building of S. C. Dillard and another of said notices duly certified to as aforesaid on the front of the blacksmith shop and the remaining notice duly certified to by G. W. Benson County Clerk as aforesaid on the front of the yard of S. C. Miller, all in the immediate vicinity and within the town of Dillard Station Douglas County State of Oregon, said notices being so posted on the 29th day of January 1894 being more than 30 days immediately preceding the first day of the March Term of County Court for said County and State.

And it appearing to the Court that said premises although platted into town lots as in petition alleged is only valuable for agricultural purposes and that said premises being so platted, as aforesaid into town lots is rendered much less valuable; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that no person will be injured by the by the vacation of said lots, streets blocks and alleys

It is hereby ordered and decreed that the following described premises be

vacated and the same is hereby vacated with  
 Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14, Lots 1, 2, 3, 14, 15 & 16 in  
 Block 15, and Lots 6, 7, 8 & 9 in Block 16, and Blocks  
 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 & 30 in said Douglas  
 County Oregon, together with the following named  
 streets Douglas Street, Oregon Street, Water Street,  
 from the intersection of Water and Second Streets  
 to the Northern limit of said town plat, Rock  
 Street, Fourth Street, First Street, Third Street  
 from the intersection of Third and Bellard  
 Streets to the Eastern limit of said town  
 plat, and all the alleys except the alleys  
 in Blocks 15 and 16, as shown by said  
 town plat filed in the Clerk's office  
 of Douglas County State of Oregon on  
 the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1892 and recorded  
 in Volume 13 of Records of Deeds, page 27  
 thereof of Douglas County Oregon

In the Matter of the Assessment  
 of  
 S. Hamilton for the year 1893

It appearing that at  
 the September term 1893 of the County Court  
 sitting as a board of equalization an order  
 was duly made and entered increasing  
 the assessment of S. Hamilton on the tax  
 rolls of 1893 in money, notes and accounts  
 \$18,000 and it appearing that the Assessor in entering  
 the said Order upon the tax rolls through mis-  
 take increased the said assessment to \$18,000  
 thereby increasing the said assessment only \$11,000.

It is therefore ordered that the sheriff and  
 county clerk be and are hereby authorized to  
 correct the said assessment of S. Hamilton upon  
 the assessment Rolls of 1893, by adding to the orig-  
 inal assessment \$18,000, <sup>and</sup> hereby <sup>qualify</sup> the assessment  
 of the said S. Hamilton on money notes & accounts  
 \$ 25,000.<sup>00</sup>
