✓ In the Matter of the petition of W.E. Davenport & others it is found that the petition is regular and that the notices were posted in public places and in the vicinity of the proposed Road and all other proceedings are regular and just compensation as Damages have been awarded by the County Board of Viewers, and the petitioners agreeing to display all costs and damages of an appeal to the District Court should not be taken.

It is therefore Ordered that said Road be granted and the Report of the viewers adopted and the road ordered opened upon the petitioners paying one half of the Damages assessed \$140.50 and the County one half, namely \$140.50.

✓ In the matter of the county road through what is known as the Black Hawk Colloid in Bond Dist. No. 22.

It is ordered that \$100.00 be appropriated out of the General Road fund to improve the same and the Clerk is authorized to draw a warrant for the same to T.H. Brown Supervisor of said District.

✓ In the Matter of the petition of A.C. Hill to vacate Lots Nos. 1-2-3-4-5 and Lots 7-8-10-11-12-13 and 14 in the town of Dellard according to the allegations between said lots in Bond No. 16 in said town, there being no objection to said vacation it is hereby ordered that said lots be and are hereby vacated as prayed for in the petition.
