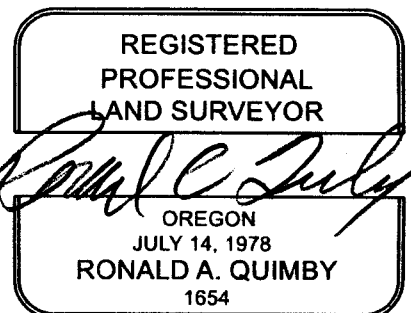
Sketch of Monument, Accessories, and General Area

*BURNED! FALLEN SHATTERED* New - Double trunk R. Cedar, southerly trunk is 14" dia. & is scribed "1/4 S36 CS BT" bears N.5 1/2°E., 9.4 ft

*BURNED DEAD 14"* - 14" dia., D. Fir, double blazed & scribed "1/4 S35 CS BT" bears S.26°W., 6.2 ft. *FHOB*
