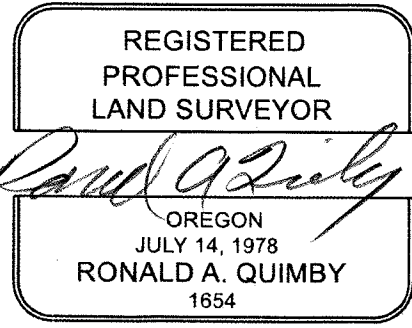

 18" now 24" dia. 3½ ft. high stump with a rotted out center old axe marks & a blaze bears S.81°E., 32.2 ft. (Rec. N.88°E., 31.0 ft. dist. possible face measurements) Orig. BT.  
 No other original BTs found.  
 12" now 16" W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze bears S.48°E., 89.0 ft. (per record)  
 4" now 6" dia. W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze bears North 32.3 ft. (per record)  
 New BTs - 14" dia. W.Oak (was thought to be NW BT per 1951, we opened, no scribing was found) single blazed & scribed "T26S R5W S9 CS BT" bears N.43¾°W., 39.9 ft.  
 4" dia. W.Oak double blazed & scribed "X BT" bears S.21°E., 46.5 ft.
