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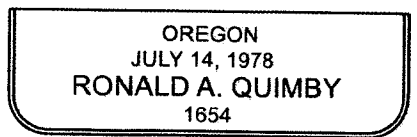
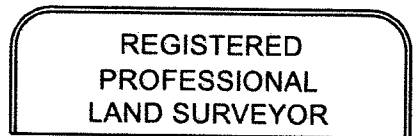
Sketch of Monument, Accessories, and General Area

- A Cedar 8" dia., bears N.65°E., 48 lks. dist. mkd. T31S R9W S18 BT.
- A Fir 40" dia., bears S.32°W., 28 lks. dist. mkd. T31S R10W S24 BT.
- A Fir 24" dia., bears N.88°W., 33 lks. dist. mkd. T31S R10W S13 BT.

- A sawed Fir stump 36" dia., bears S.32°W., 28 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
