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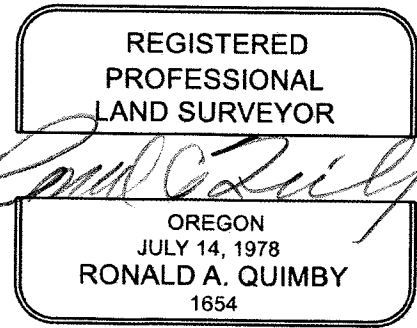

BLM remonumentation by Hans W. Thielsen, Cadastral Surveyor under Group No. 350, surveyed April 11, 1957 - (DCSO records Vol. 33 Page 13873)

The remonumentation. of the 1/4 sec.. cor, of secs 14 & 23, T32S R9W as requested the District Forester of the Medford. Forest District, BLM. The Kelsey-Mule Ck Rd is to be constructed through the corner position, and it was necessary to establish reference monuments in order to perpetuate the corner position

Point for the 1/4 cor, of secs 14 and 23, determined at record distances from the remains of the original BTs as follows:

- A sawed fir stump, 20" dia,, bears S.32°E., 32 lks. 21 1/2 marked with an open blaze. (Record bearing N.16°E.)
- A sawed fir stump, 32" dia,, bears S.6 1/2°E., 50 lks., 30 3/4 marked 23 in open blaze.

No monument established at the true corner point from the corner point

An iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia set 22" <sup>132 00</sup> in the ground for a reference monument bears N.16°W., 200 lks with brass cap marked 1/4 S14 T32S R9W RM 1957 and an arrow pointing to the true corner, PROF. 12" ADD ROUGH MOUND OF STONE AROUND BASE

An iron. post, 48" long, 2 1/2" dia. set 22" <sup>132 00</sup> in the ground for a reference monument bears S.16°E., 200 lks. with brass cap marked 1/4 S23 T32S R9W RM 1957 and an arrow pointing to the true corner,
