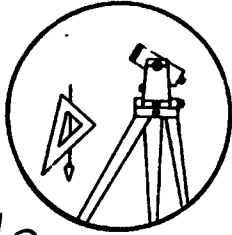


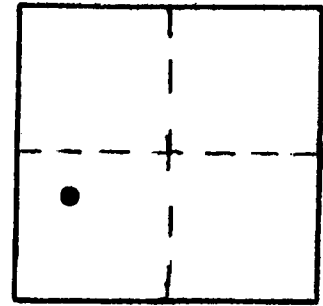

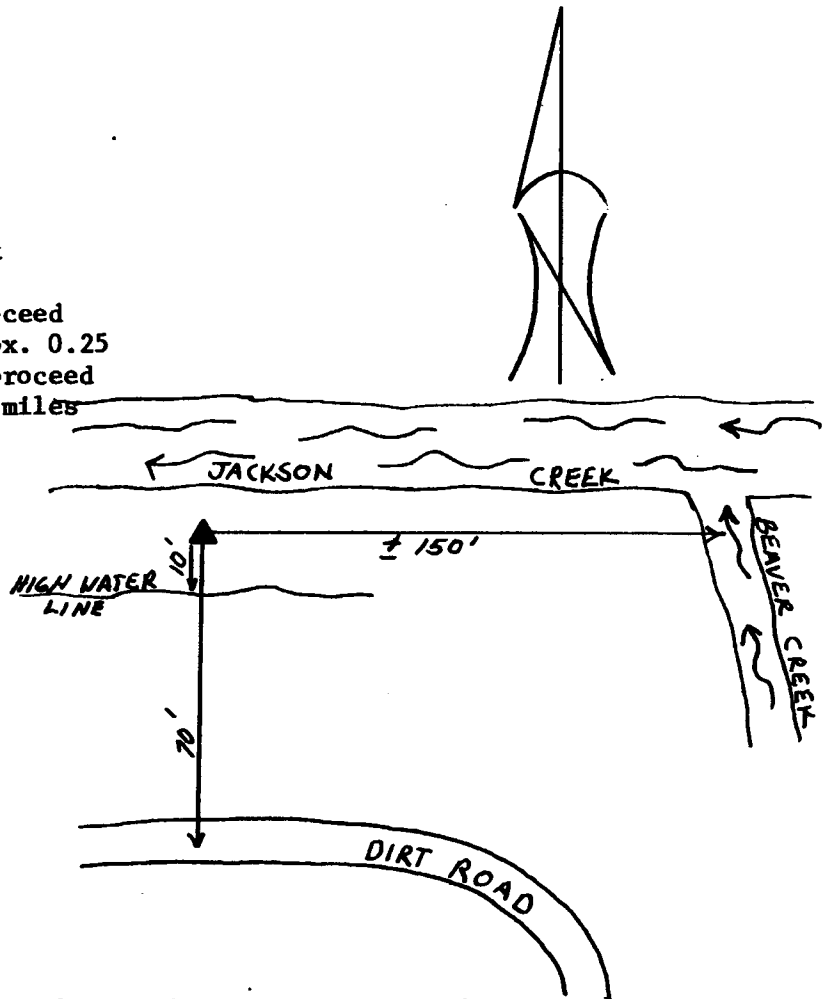

TO REACH:

From the intersection of Jackson Creek
 Rd. (USFS Rd. #29) and Beaver Creek Rd.
 (USFS Rd. #31) in T30S, R1W, Sec. 22, proceed
 southeasterly along USFS Rd. #31 approx. 0.25
 miles to unmarked dirt road on left, proceed
 northerly along dirt road approx. 0.1 miles
 to monument on right.
