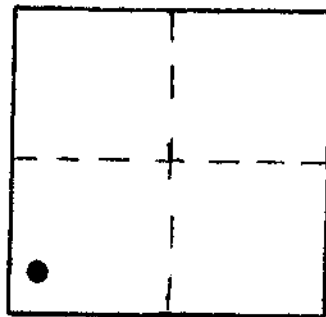

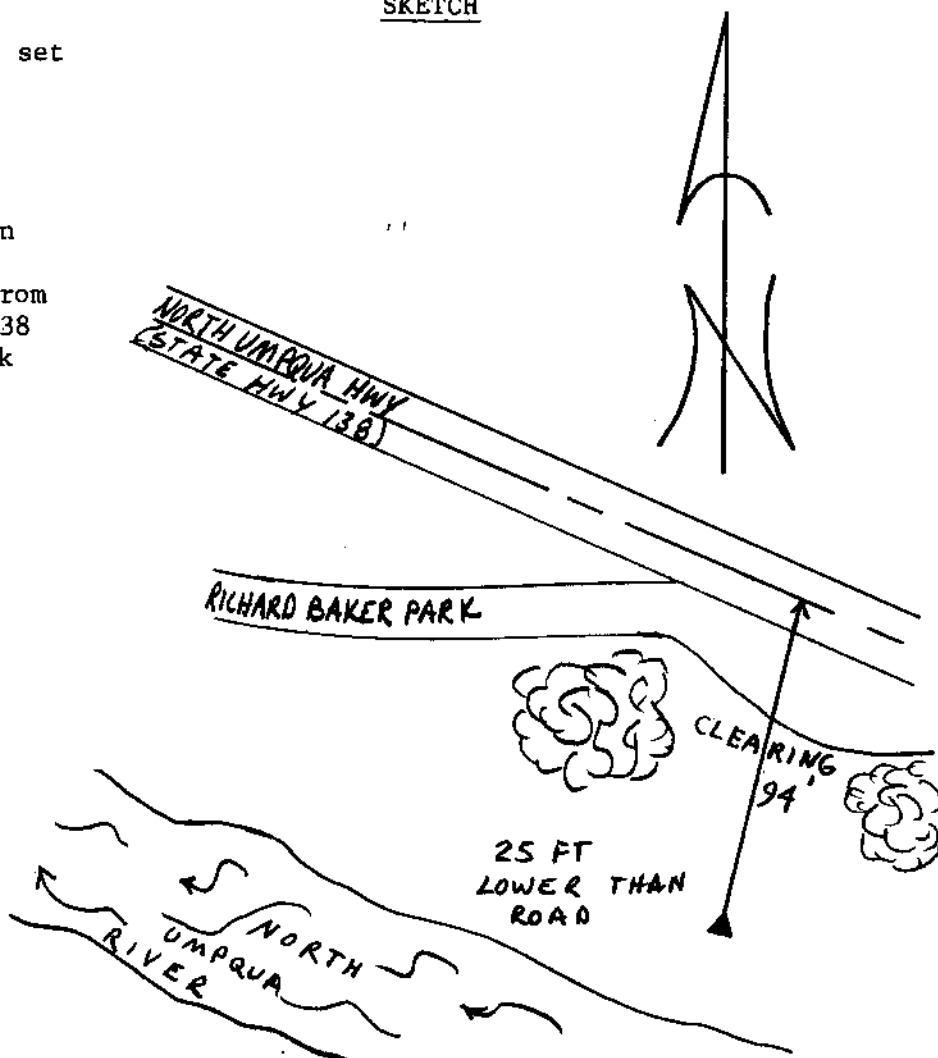
DESCRIPTION and TO REACH
