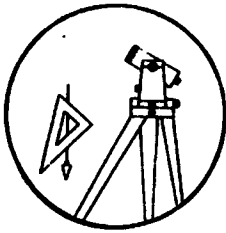

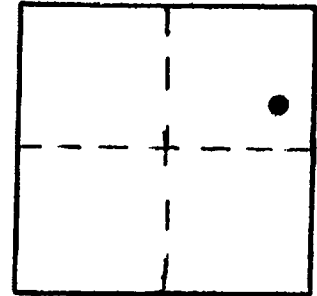

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

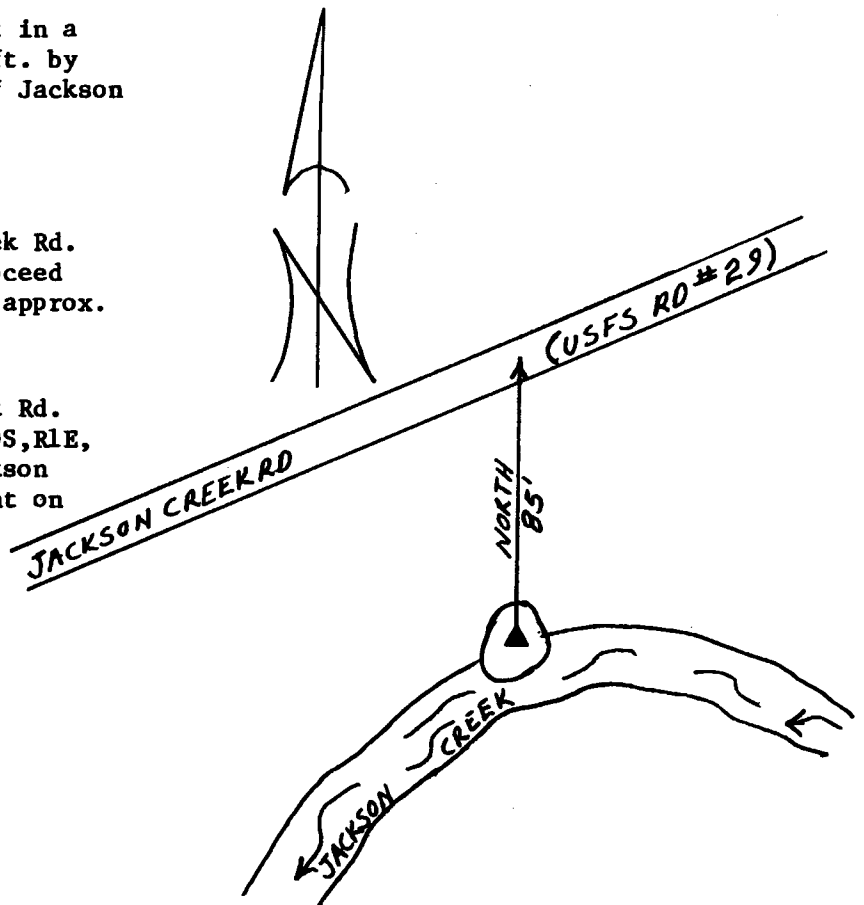
SKETCH

A USGS disk stamped "9M 1944 1889" set in a large boulder measuring 15 ft. by 11 ft. by 6 ft. high situated near the center of Jackson Creek stream bed.

TO REACH:

From Cover Campground and Jackson Creek Rd. (USFS Rd. #29) in T30S, R1E, Sec.17, proceed northeasterly along Jackson Creek Rd. approx. 1.7 miles to monument on right.

From the intersection of Jackson Creek Rd. (USFS Rd. #29) and USFS Rd. #30 in T30S, R1E, Sec.2 proceed northeasterly along Jackson Creek Rd. approx. 1.0 miles to monument on right.
