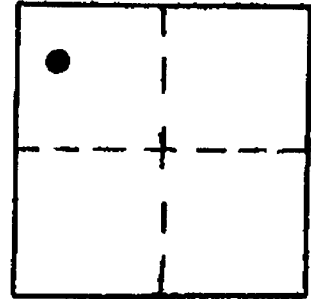

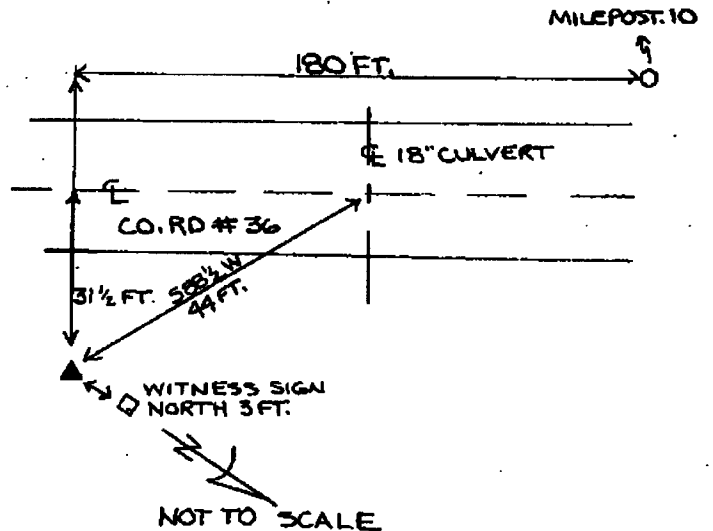

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

Found: A standard DCSO disk set in boulder stamped "C-132 1973". Disk is 1 ft. above ground and approx. 6 ft. above road surface. Witness post and sign 3 ft. north.

To reach: From Azalea exit off I-5 proceed easterly along Co. Rd. #36 (Cow Creek Rd.) to intersection with BLM road #31-4-27 (McGinnis Creek Rd. in T31S R4W sec. 27) From intersection proceed easterly along Co. Rd. #36 2.5 mi. to monument on the left. (or from intersection Co. Rd. #36 and BLM Rd. #32-4-2 proceed westerly along Co. Rd. #36 0.1 mile. to station.)
