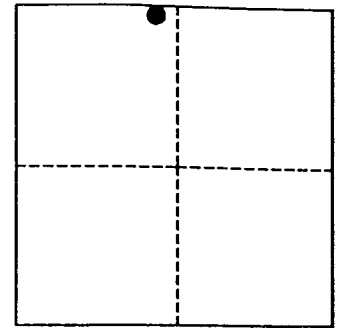
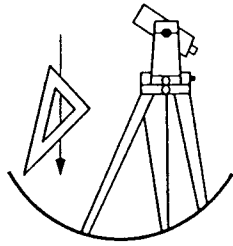

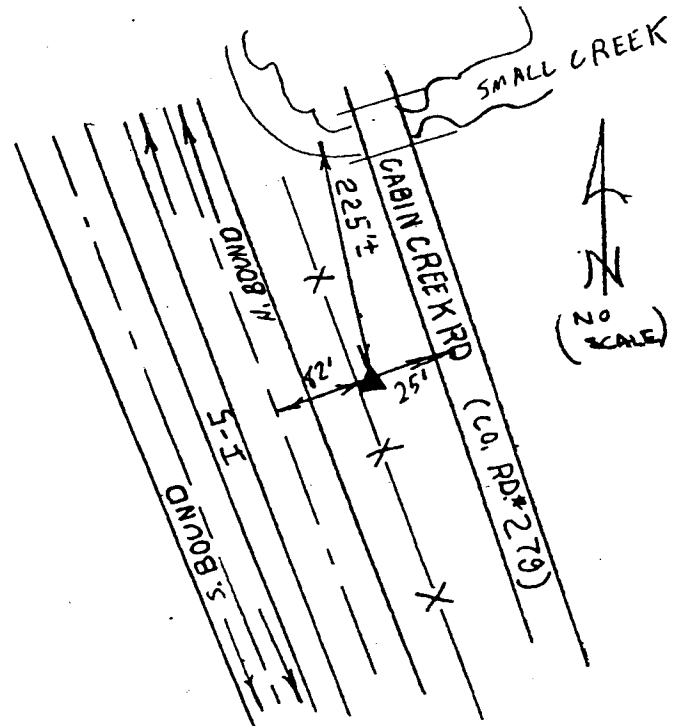

Found: A 9/16 inch diameter stainless steel rod set under a 6 - 7/8 inch diameter aluminum collar and access cover, set in concrete, collar is stamped "C 749 1987" and is flush with the ground.

To reach: From the intersection of I-5 and Metz Hill Rd. (Metz Hill Road, Co. Rd. #74) at exit 142 in T24S R5W Sec. 29, proceed northerly along I-5, 1.05 miles to monument on right at milepost 143.25.
